Victorian Youth Week, Nillumbik Shire

Every year Victorian Youth Week is an exciting showcase that celebrates the talents, skills and ideas of diverse young people across Victoria. Due to COVID-19, this year it will look a little different, with events taking place online between **15 November to 15 December 2020**.

We know this year has been particularly challenging for young people. So now, more than ever, events and activities are an opportunity for young people to connect with their friends, peers and communities.

This is an exciting opportunity to reimagine Youth Week, so Nillumbik Shire Council's Youth Development team want to support young and up and coming artists to deliver virtual music, arts and culture events and activities that will be pre-recorded and hosted on our social media, thereby creating unique opportunities to engage young people in Nillumbik.

Applications

Young people aged 12-25 years old are invited to **Takeover** Nillumbik Youth social media by submitting an application to host a pre-recorded video of a music performance or other arts and/or cultural activities. The activity can be anything suitable for streaming on social media for a minimum of 20 minutes and up to a maximum of 60 minutes in duration.

Once approved, pre-recorded videos will be streamed on the Nillumbik Youth Facebook and/or Instagram throughout 'Youth Week' between 15 November to 15 December.

A payment of \$150 per approved video will be made to all successful applicants.

Examples of performances or activities you can apply for include:

- Live music performance
- DJ Set
- Art demonstration
- Skills based workshop / how to videos
- Cooking
- Mindfulness
- Fitness
- Learning another language/sign language
- Plus so much more!

Applications can be made online at <https://nillumbik.smartygrants.com.au> and must include:

- Brief biography
- A written concept of the event accompanied by a sample video recording
- Link to business Instagram and Facebook (if applicable)
- Acknowledgement of copyright if the artwork/performance/activity is not your own creation
- An ABN or ATO statement of supplier letter (link provided in application)

Eligibility

- Individuals or collaborative groups are welcome to apply.
- Applications will be accepted from young people aged 12-25 years old
- Applicants must live, work, volunteer, study, play or have some other connection to Nillumbik
- Events/activities must be pre-recorded and submitted in video format for a minimum of 20 minutes and up to a maximum of 60 minutes in duration

Assessment

Applications will be evaluated on:

- Merit of the work submitted
- Creative approach
- Suitability and feasibility of proposed activity

Key Dates

Applications will open on **26 October 2020** and will remain open until **Monday 9 November 2020**.

Applicants will be notified of the outcome of their application by Friday 13 November.

Terms and Conditions

- Scheduling priority will be given to young people who live, work or study in the Nillumbik Shire
- Successful applications will be required to pre-record and submit their work to Nillumbik Youth prior to being streamed on Facebook and/or Instagram
- Funding will be paid after the content has been produced and provided to Council
- Applicants are encouraged to 'Like' and 'Follow' Nillumbik Youth on Facebook and Instagram and share their accounts so they can be tagged and acknowledged in the post
- Successful applicants will own the rights to their content submissions
- By entering, the applicant consents to Nillumbik Youth using their content for the promotion of the Youth Week Takeover event
